

# LABRE – Brazilian League of Amateur Radio

## 92 YEARS – AWARD | OFFICIAL REGULATIONS

### 1 – OBJECTIVE

To commemorate the 92nd anniversary of LABRE – Brazilian League of Amateur Radio, promoting amateur radio activity, integration among operators, and appreciation of Brazil's different regions.

### 2 – EVENT PERIOD

The event will begin on February 1, 2026 (00:00 UTC) and end on February 28, 2026 (23:59 UTC).

### 3 – ACTIVATED STATIONS

Twenty-eight stations will be active during the event, representing the Brazilian states and LABRE National:

Acre – ZV8AC | Alagoas – ZV7AL | Amapá – ZV8AP | Amazonas – ZV8AM | Bahia – ZV6BA | Ceará – ZV7CE  
Federal District – ZV2DF | Espírito Santo – ZV1ES | Goiás – ZV2GO | Maranhão – ZV8MA  
Mato Grosso – ZV9MT | Mato Grosso do Sul – ZV9MS | Minas Gerais – ZV4MG | Paraíba – ZV7PB  
Pará – ZV8PA | Paraná – ZV5PR | Pernambuco – ZV7PE | Piauí – ZV8PI  
Rio de Janeiro – ZV1RJ | Rio Grande do Norte – ZV7RN | Rio Grande do Sul – ZV3RS  
Rondônia – ZV8RO | Roraima – ZV8RR | Santa Catarina – ZV5SC | São Paulo – ZV2SP  
Sergipe – ZV6SE | Tocantins – ZV2TO | LABRE National – ZV2LB

The stations will be operated exclusively by authorized amateur radio operators and shall hereinafter be referred to as “special stations”.

### 4 – MODES

Phone (SSB, FM, DV), CW, and digital modes (FT8, FT4, RTTY, among others).

### 5 – BANDS

HF, VHF, UHF, and Satellite.

### 6 – SCORING

Scoring will be based on the total number of valid QSOs made.

### 7 – CONTACT VALIDATION

It is permitted to work the same special station on the same band provided different modes are used. Duplicate QSOs on the same band and mode will not be validated.

### 8 – AWARDS

#### 8.1 – HUNTERS

8.1.1 – Special digital certificates for top scores in:

All Modes, Phone, CW, VHF, and Satellite.

8.1.2 – Digital Certificates:

Gold (50 QSOs / VHF and Satellite: 15)

Silver (40 QSOs / VHF and Satellite: 10)

Bronze (30 QSOs / VHF and Satellite: 5)

Participation (5 QSOs / VHF and Satellite: 1)

8.1.3 – Categories:

All Modes, Digital, Phone, CW, VHF, and Satellite.

8.1.4 – LABRE Certificates:

Contact with the 27 state stations (28 except ZV2LB) automatically grants the WAB and WID certificates.

## **9 – ACTIVATORS**

9.1 – Participation certificates will be granted to all activators.

9.1.1 – Special digital certificates (Gold, Silver, and Bronze) for:

Phone, CW, Digital, VHF, and Satellite.

## **10 – LOG SUBMISSION**

No log submission is required from hunter stations. All QSO verification and scoring will be handled automatically by the HAMPASS platform.

## **11 – RANKING MONITORING**

Updated rankings will be available in real time on the HAMPASS platform.

## **12 – FINAL PROVISIONS**

Participation in the event implies full acceptance of these regulations. LABRE, through its Organizing Committee, shall have final authority on any matters related to or not provided for herein.
